Guidelines for Vendor Set-up & Breakdown

Note: Even if you have filled out an application, you must send in your payment before the event to ensure you have a space. Filling out an application doesn't ensure you a space if you have not paid for it.

- Vendors should be set up by 9:00 am on April 8th. There will be someone there at 7:00 am. Spaces will be assigned by the Vendor Coordinator.
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- All vehicles must be removed from Oracle Community Center premises before 8:30am.
- Break down of your booth is scheduled for 4:00 pm. No early breakdown is allowed before that time. This is for the safety of the people, still on the premises and vehicles present a hazard.
- You are responsible for all set-up and break-down of your equipment.
- Do not remove any boulders or rocks set up in the Community Center garden area and parking lot.
- You are responsible for your trash removal and disposal in appropriate bins. Please leave your space clean so someone else doesn't have to clean up after you.
